

In the darkness, the fire is kindled. The celebrant greets the people and prays for the blessing of the new fire and the people. The Pascal Candle, lighted from the new fire, is carried in procession, to the Altar. At three points, the person carrying the candle will pause, lift high the candle, and say:

*Layreader: The Light of Christ
People: Thanks be to God.*

Candles distributed to the congregation are lighted from the servers’ candles as the procession moves to the Altar.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
