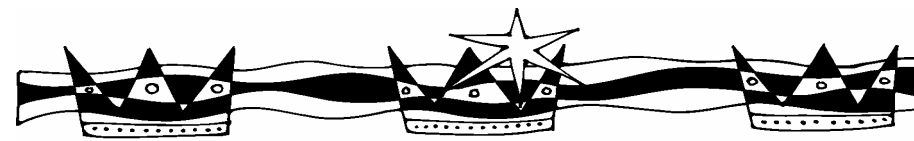

We welcome members of 1<sup>st</sup> St. Margaret’s Scouts who are holding their annual Church Parade today in celebration of Scout-Guide Week, held every February around the shared birthday of Lord Robert Baden-Powell (B-P) and his wife and collaborator, Lady Olave Baden-Powell (February 22). Scouting began in 1907 when Lt.-Gen. Robert Baden-Powell took a group of youth to a camp on Brownsea Island. There is evidence that a few Scouting groups started up in Canada in 1907. The Canadian General Council of the Boy Scout Association was incorporated by an act of the Canadian Parliament on June 12, 1914. In 2007, our name was officially changed to Scouts Canada.

Today, Scouts Canada is a diverse organization with over 100,000 members representing every faith and culture. Scouts Canada offers programming in more than 19 languages reflecting Canada's multicultural landscape and communities. St. Margaret’s relationship with Scouting goes back at least to the 1920s.
