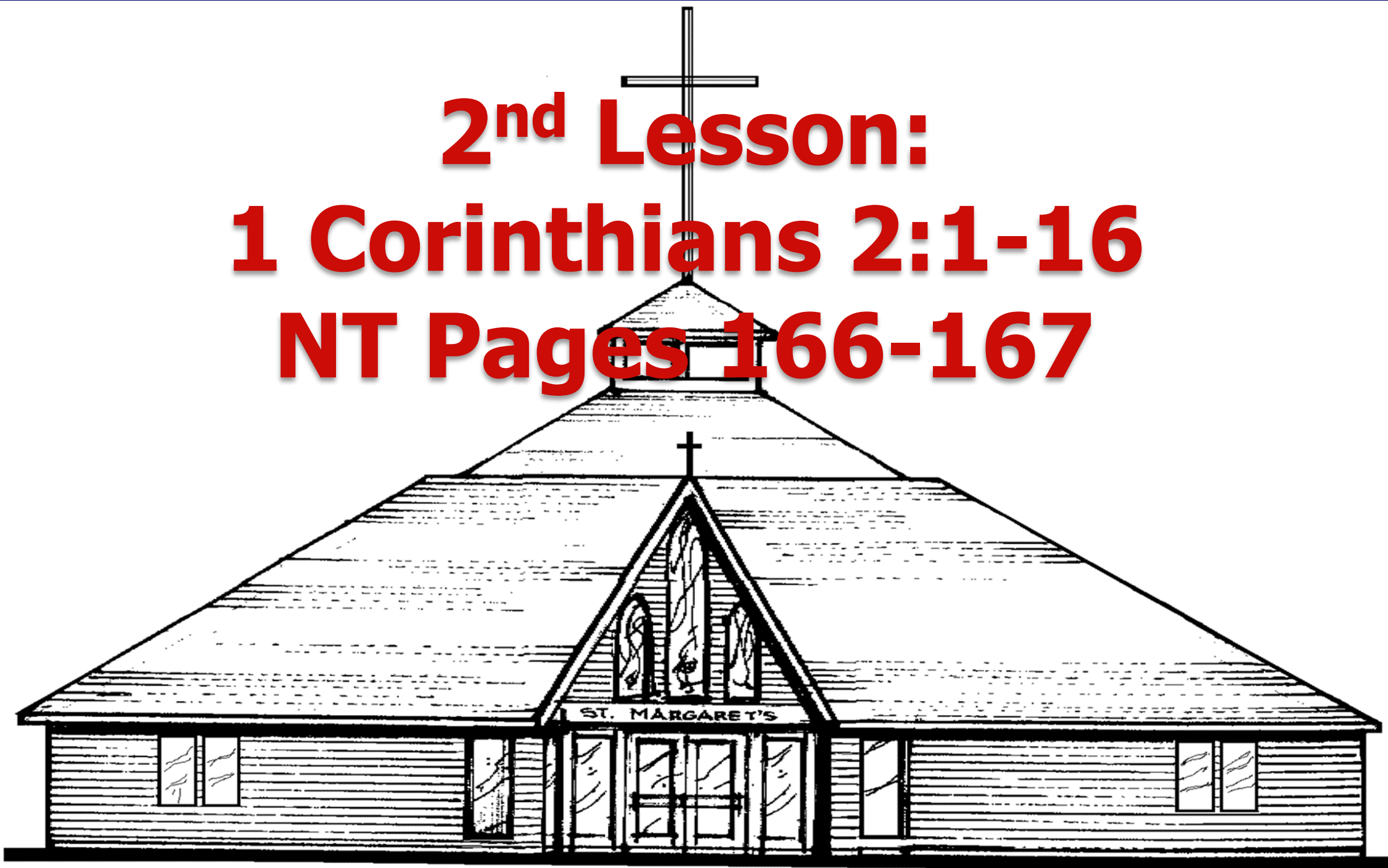

## The Nicene Creed

**Celebrant:** Let us confess our faith, as we say,
