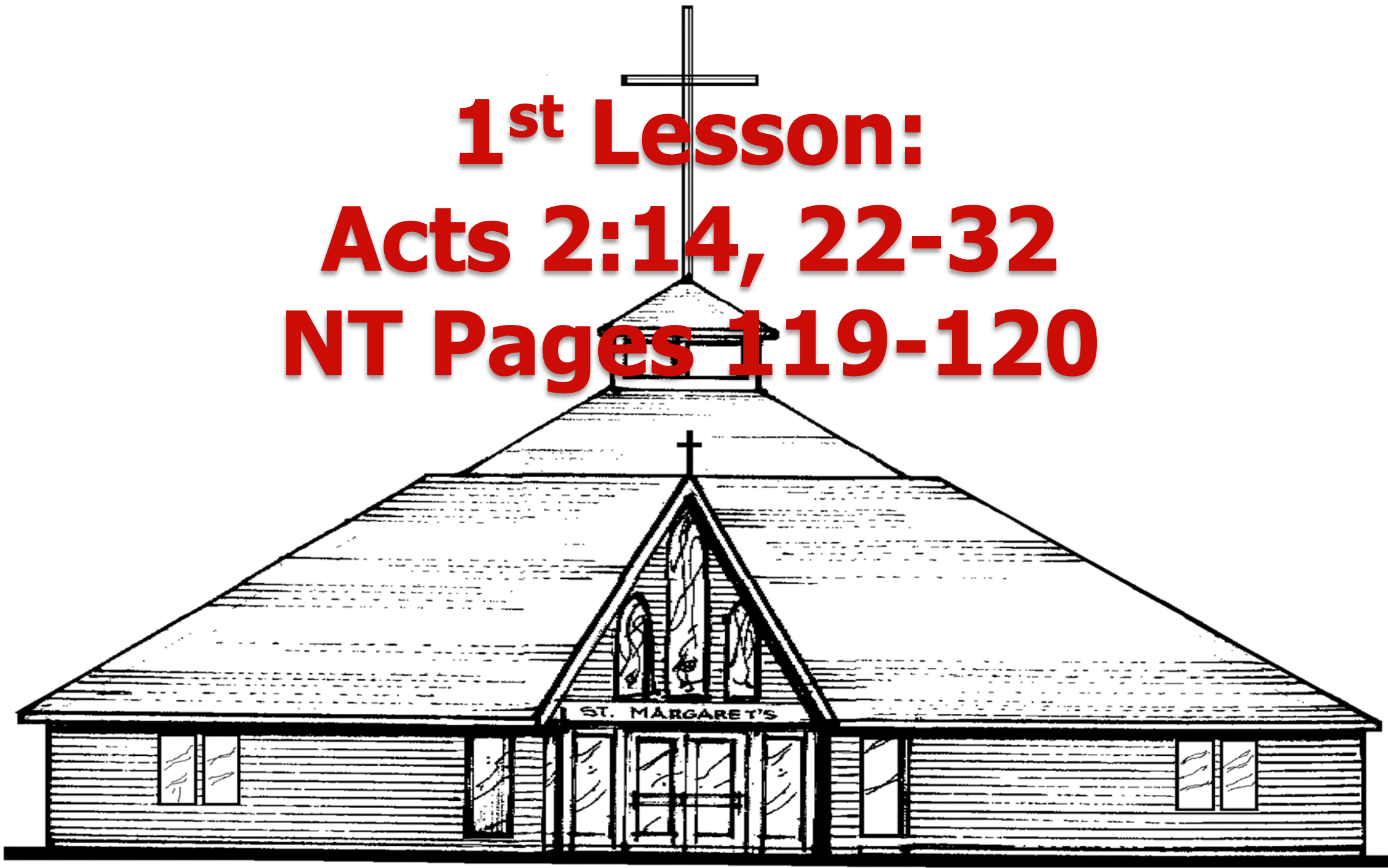
Alleluia!
