**Make me hear of joy and gladness, that the body you have broken may rejoice.**

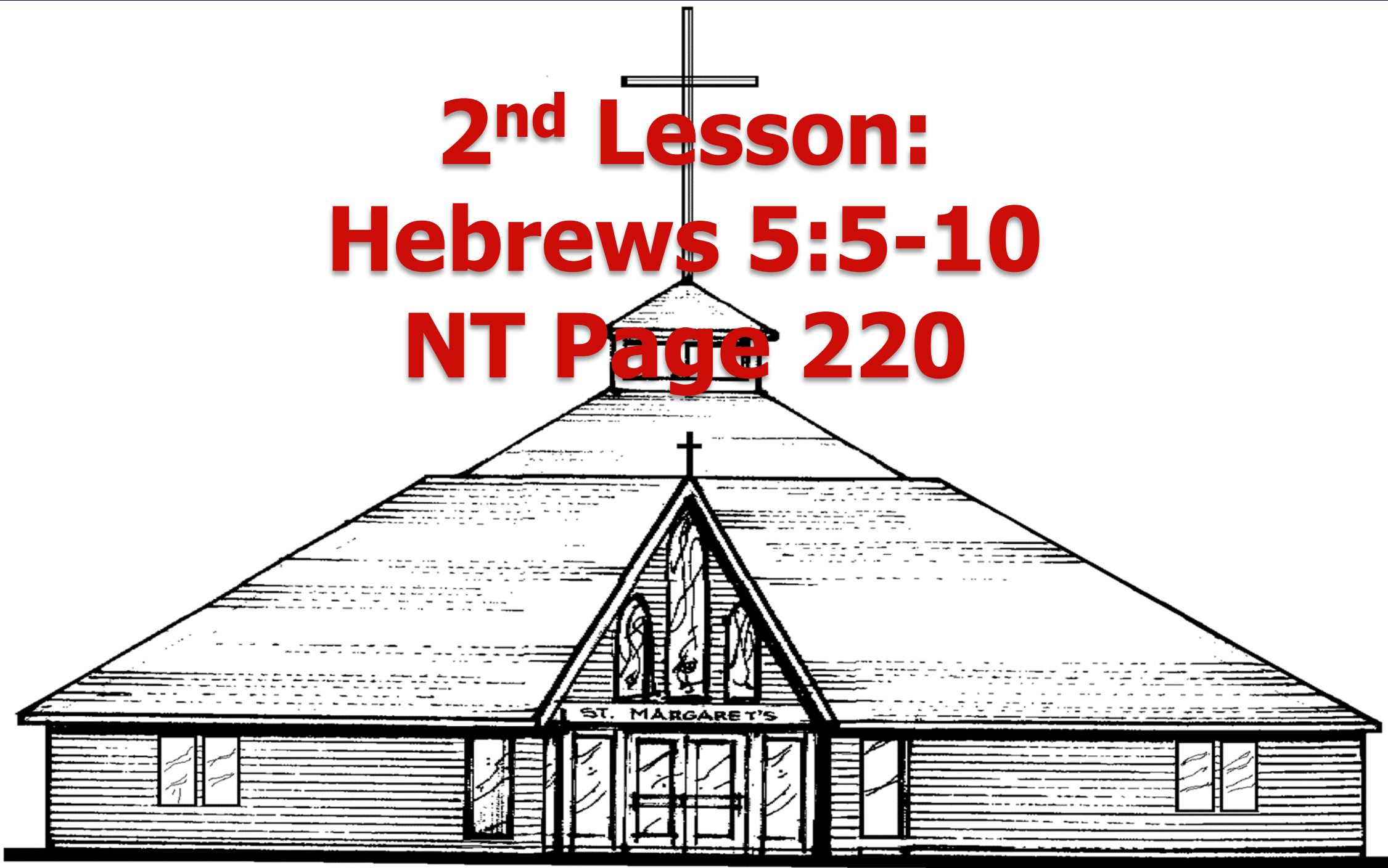
**Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities.**

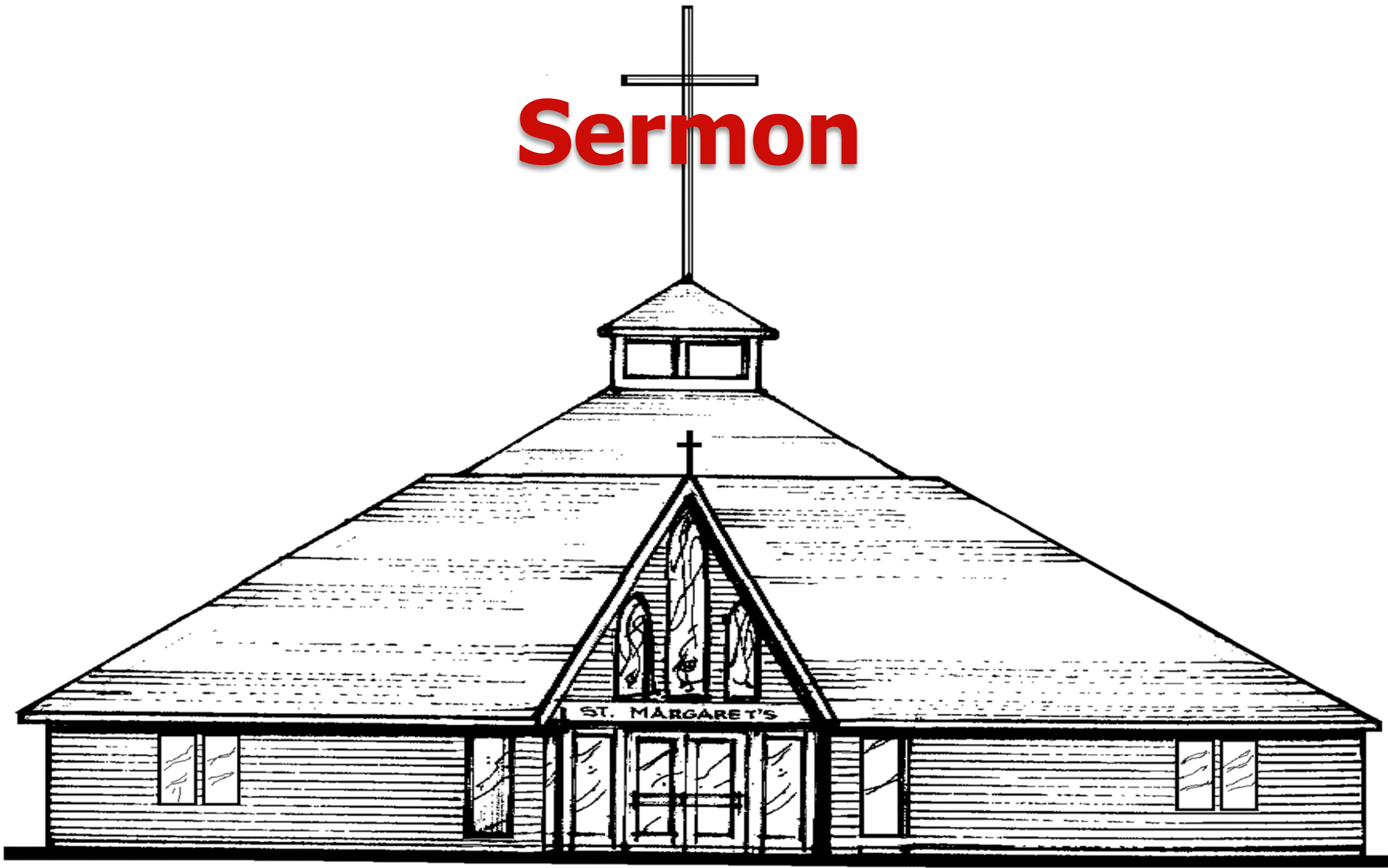
