

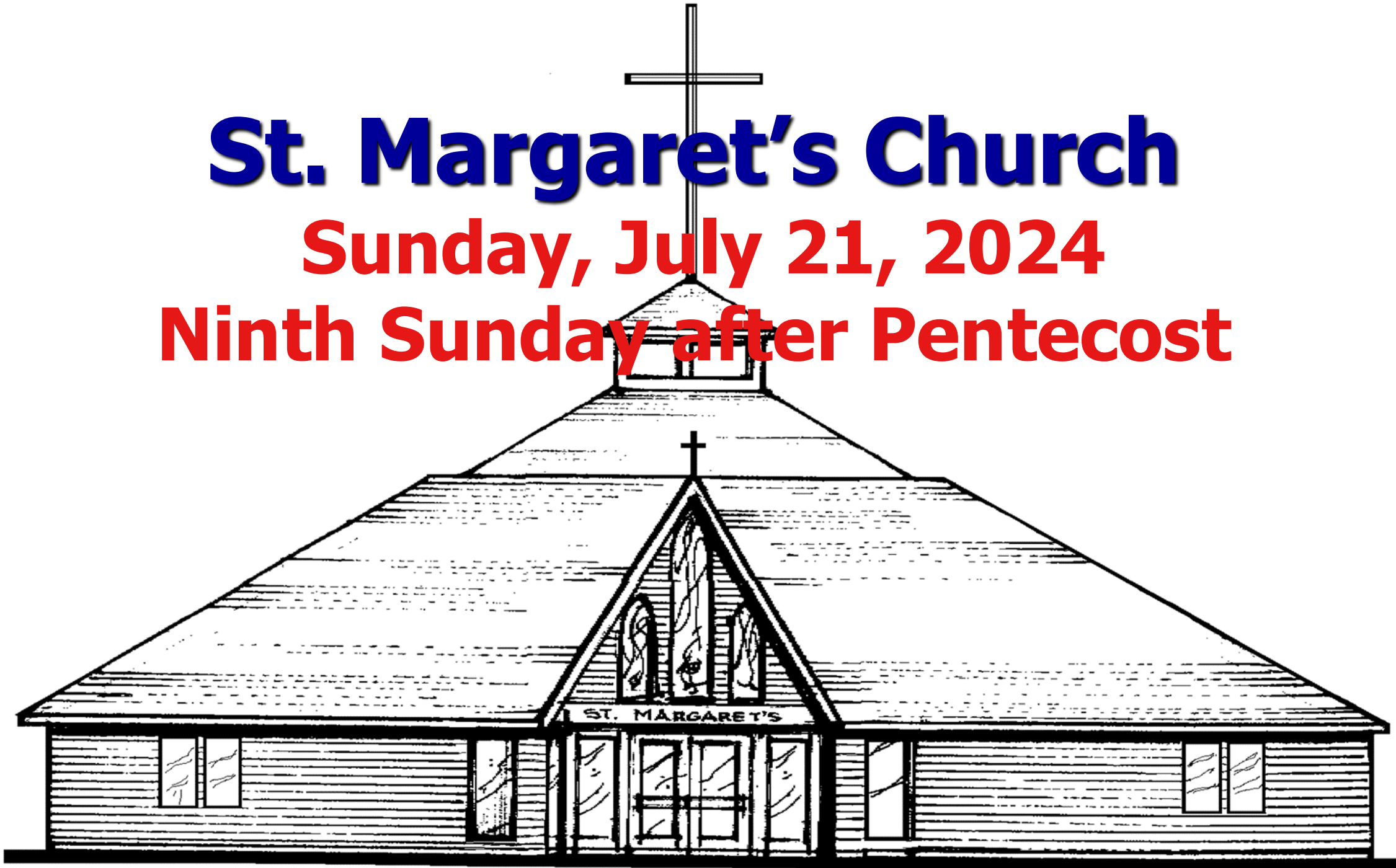

**In his hand are the caverns of the earth, and the heights of the hills are his also.**

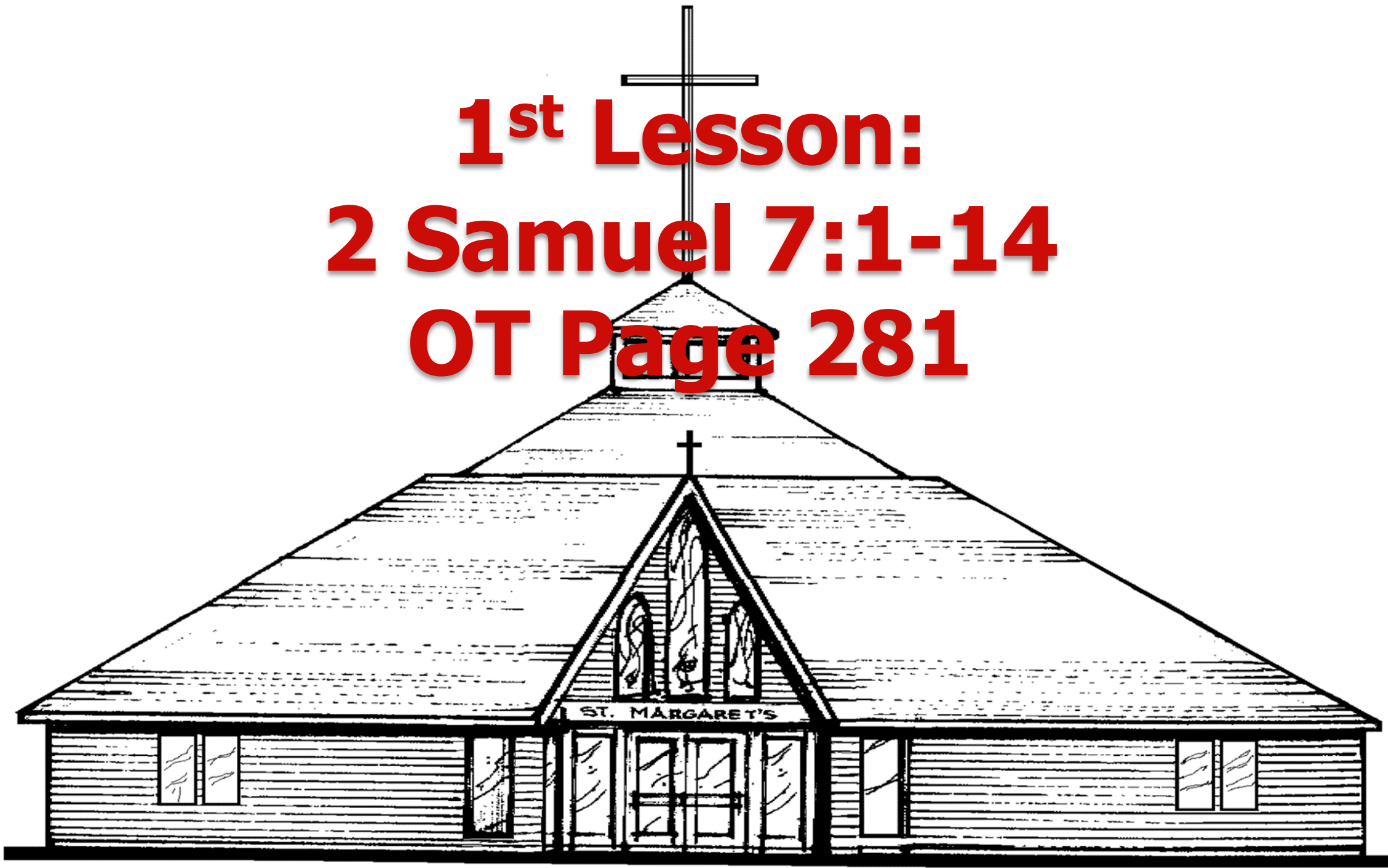
**The sea is his for he made it, and his hands have moulded the dry land.**

**If they break my statutes and do not keep my commandments;**

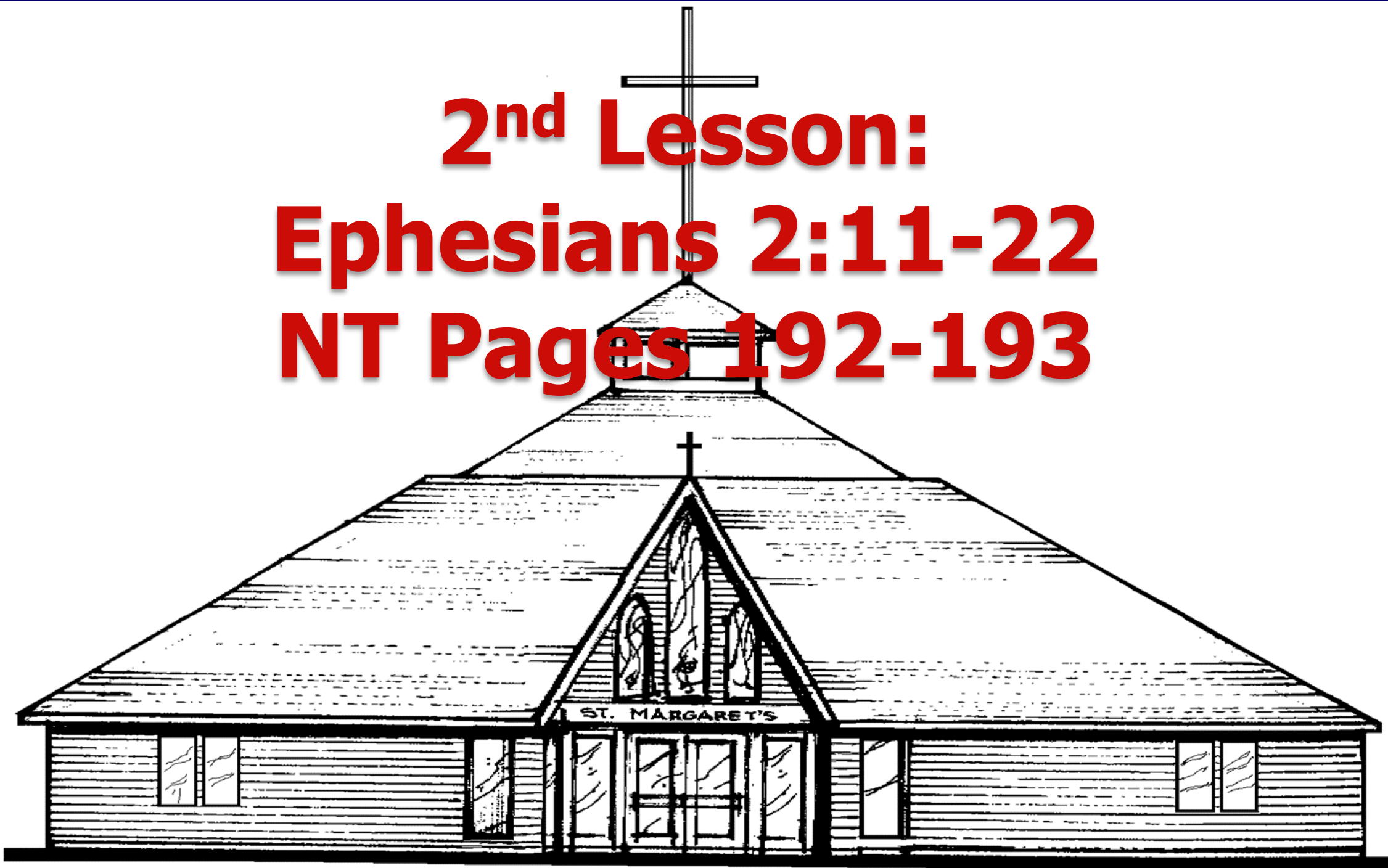
**I will punish their transgressions with a rod

**It shall stand fast for evermore like the moon, the abiding witness in the sky.'”**

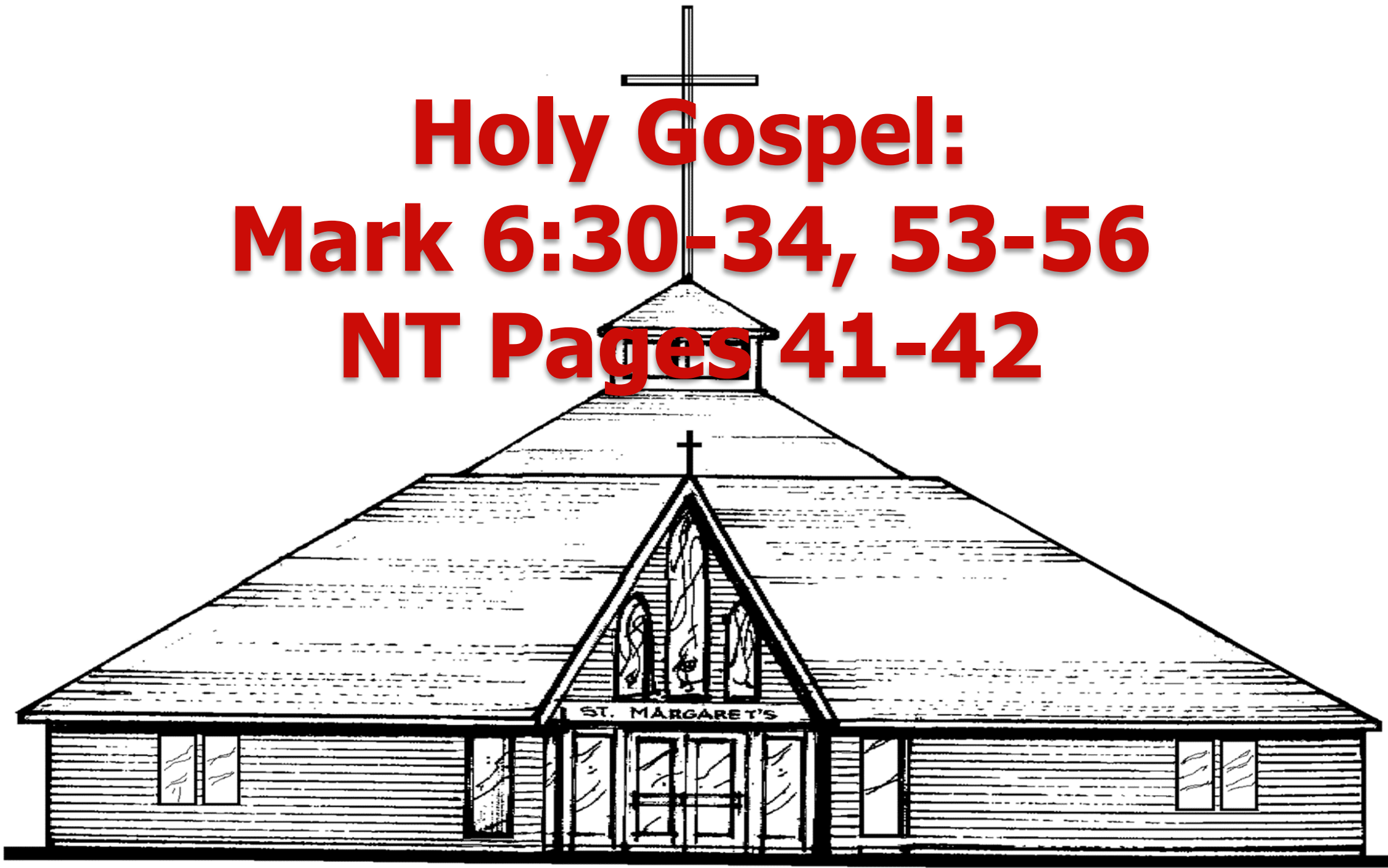

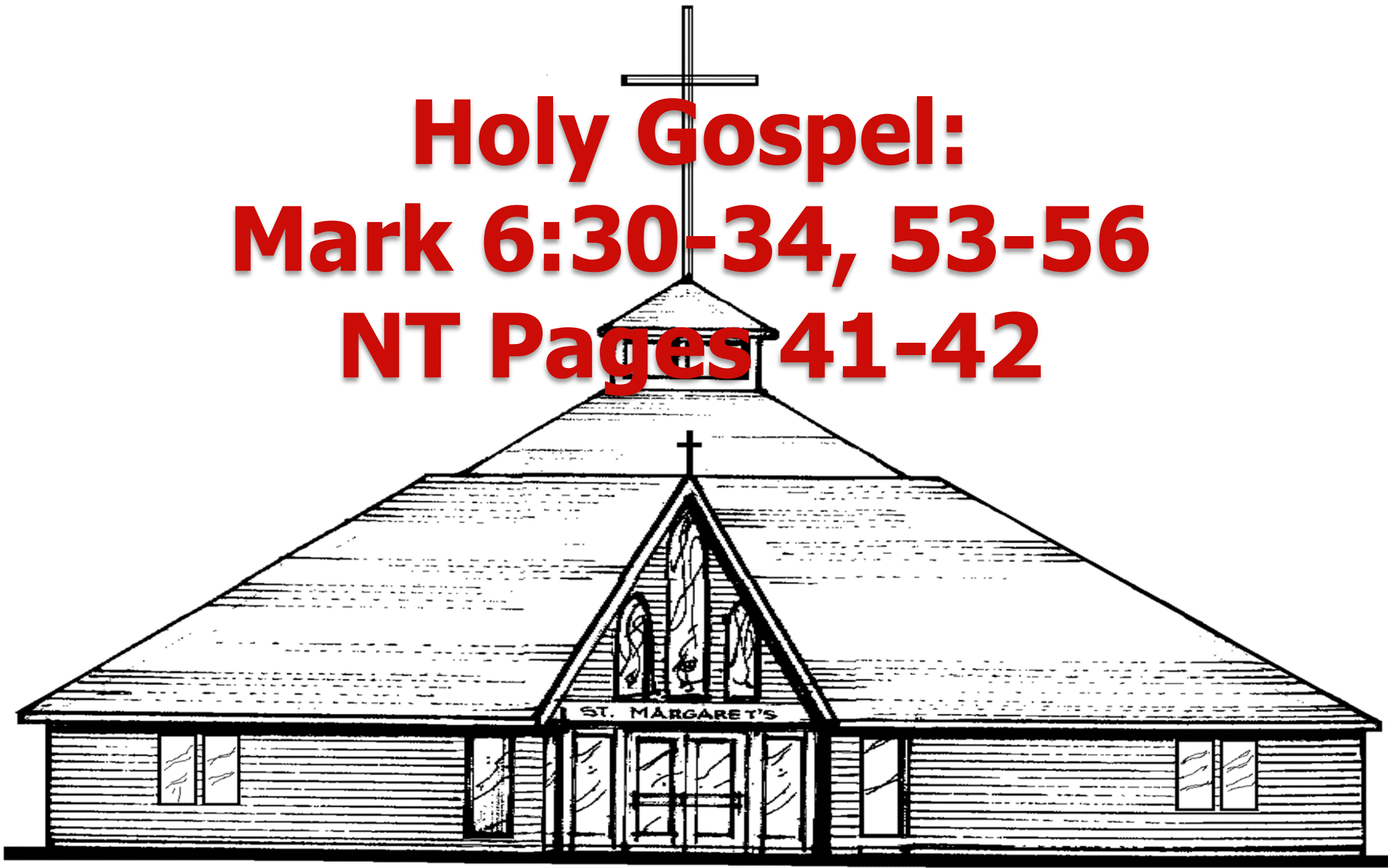

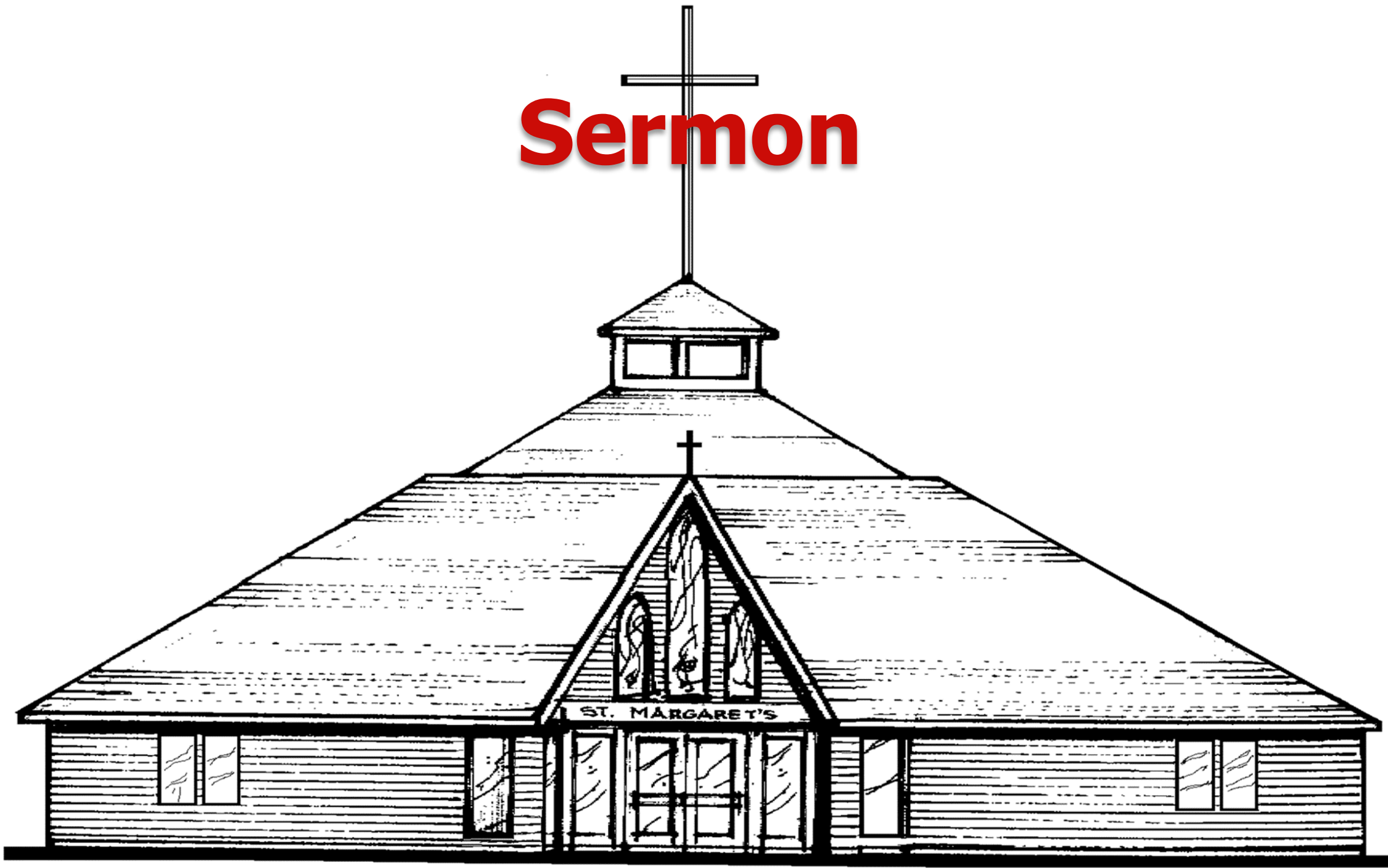
